Election Update: November 4, 2025 – Statewide Special & Municipal General & Special Election

Challenges

- O Staffing of precincts, mainly due to call outs and sicknesses.
- Issues with encoding voter access cards on Election Day morning. This problem was outside of Spalding's control, and an email was received by KNOWiNK, the vendor for the poll pads that the problem was resolved prior to noon. We noticed a major difference in incoming calls by noon on Election Day.
- Leaks throughout the main office, equipment room, and Advance Voting location. The problem seems to be worse after the roof was worked on.
- **Overall Successful election.** There may have been a delay intermittently, but it would have been very, very short and voters were processed in a timely manner.

Remodeling of newly acquired space: Director Slaughter continues to work with LJA and the floor plans for the newly acquired space. This is a work in progress.

<u>Precinct Consolidation</u> –Kim Slaughter advised that saving money for the county and the taxpayers is not the only reason for the consolidation of precincts. Streamlining of staffing, easier staffing, better staffing of precincts as well. At the December meeting Director Slaughter will present more information on the consolidation.
